

Dear FEGC Member,

GREAT NEWS!!!

Announcing several positive new changes to our Club. Please thoroughly read this in its entirety.

1. **To help reduce the out-of-pocket expense for our members, we will soon be able to use Pro Shop Credits to pay for Greens Fees and Cart Fees.**
2. **All current FEGC Members will receive 10% off their total order for any merchandise in all City of Tucson Pro Shops.**
3. **Prize pools for Weekly Tournaments will increase by about \$40 per event without increasing your fees.**
4. **We have added a regular weekday tournament on Thursdays. You now have an opportunity to play tournament golf twice a week.**

DETAILS!!!

□ NEW PRO SHOP CREDITS SYSTEM:

- Beginning Feb. 3, 2012, at all of the City of Tucson golf courses, if you want to pay for Greens Fees and/or Cart Fees with Pro Shop Credits, simply notify the Cashier. You may use the Credits to pay for all or a portion of your Greens & Cart fees, Annual Passes, Merchandise, and Gift Certificates for either Greens Fees or Merchandise.
- In the past, the City has supplemented our tournament winnings by 15% as Pro Shop Credits which could only be used to pay for merchandise. To allow for these changes, the 15% supplement on your current Account Balance will be removed. The system will be down on Feb. 1st & 2nd to make these adjustments. If you would like to spend any of your current balance that has the 15% supplement for merchandise only, you will need to do so before Feb. 1st.
- In case you weren't aware, our Club Greens Fees are currently discounted by 10% off the lowest posted resident rate.
- Beginning Feb. 3, FEGC members will receive 10% off all merchandise purchases, including sale merchandise, in all City of Tucson Pro Shops. The Discount will apply to your total order and you do not need to have a Credit Balance to get the discount, although you may pay for all or a portion of your order with those Credits. You must show that you are a current member for 2012 by printing a Current Handicap Card from any Pro Shop Computer and showing it to the Cashier.

□ INCREASING PRIZE POOLS:

- The weekly Tournament Coordinators will no longer be paid the \$40 they have received in the past. Instead, the Coordinators will receive free entry into the Tournament Game plus Gross and Net Skins. This will increase the pool by \$22.
- We have decided to eliminate Socials at the Jameson Best Ball and the Ryder Cup, which allows us to reduce the Social Fund contribution of the Game Fee to \$1 instead of \$1.50. That will increase the prize pool by \$15 to \$20.

□ THURSDAY TOURNAMENTS:

- We began our regular Thursday Tournaments last week, which was skins only, and it drew 15 players. Beginning Thursday, Jan. 26 the Tournament will be run the same as we run our regular weekend events. Pricing will be the same as the weekend Tournaments. Thursday play will count to qualify for the Club Championship. The Hole in One pot, Best of the Year and the Enke Tour Challenge will be in play.
- We hope to draw New Members to the Club by initiating the Thursday games. Please let your friends know about it.
- Signup Sheets will be managed by the Pro Shop. Simply call the Pro Shop to sign up.
