2. **2009 Membership Dues:** Payment of Membership dues for 2010 is just around the corner. Additionally there will be the voluntary \$5 for the Hole-in-One fund. **Ken Hyland** recently won with his ace at LaPaloma. The AGA is modifying its dues payment procedures for 2010. Unfortunately, not all things are known at this writing. They do promise to have it all worked out by October 1<sup>st</sup>. Stay tuned.
3. **Club Championship:** The annual putting contest will kick off the **2009 Club Championship** on Saturday September 19. The Club Championship follows September 20, 26, and 27. There are currently 83 members qualified and another 22 near qualifying. This may be our biggest turnout ever. The City of India event will be held in the restaurant following the putting contest. 4. **Annual Picnic:** The annual picnic will be held the following Saturday October 3rd at Lakeside Park. (*Note: Since the picnic was moved to Saturday, the next tournament Canoa Ranch was switched to Sunday October 4<sup>th</sup>.*)
5. **Scratch Play 2009 Tournament:** The inaugural event of this tournament started in April with 26 players. After several rounds the field was down to the final two matches: Spencer Mims vs Craig Bauley and Greg Cesarek vs Bob Petrillo (*Note: Bob passed away in July*). Craig Bauley will play Greg Cesarek in the final match.
6. **Celebration of Life Tournament:** Saturday September 12<sup>th</sup> at 11:30 will be the Celebration of Life Tournament to honor **Bob Petrillo**. Golf will be a 1:00 shotgun start. The cost is \$45, which includes lunch and hors d'oeuvres after the round. Members may play in the Fred Enke tournament that day without entering the Celebration for Bob. Participants will need to prepay their green fee by check or cash only. Any proceeds will go to the American Heart Association.
7. **Pro Shop Relocated:** The Pro Shop recently moved to the restaurant building in order to save costs. The City of Tucson has been struggling with reduced income from less play, so changes needed to be made to reduce operating costs.
8. **New Trophy:** Plans are underway to build a FEGC trophy case in the restaurant area. This will be displayed in the new Pro Shop and be engraved each year with the winner's name. Kudos to Dave Brinkley for coordinating the trophy and Sal Mantione for constructing the case. Please stop by and see the new Club Championship Trophy.

**12. Website Manager:** Members with any corrections or additions of related material they would like to see posted on our website, please contact Steve Tilden.

**13. Handicap Chair:** It is expected that members will post ALL 18 hole scores regardless where they are played, not just Fred Enke Golf Club scores. If you do not have time or do not understand how to post, send the Handicap Coordinator the scores you have to be posted. Or he can show you how to sign on and use the computer located in the Fred Enke Pro Shop which is used solely for the purpose of posting members scores. Jeff Parfenchuck is the Handicap Chair. It is your responsibility to ensure your handicap is accurate.

- a. Post an accurate adjusted score for every round of golf that you play as soon as possible after the round. Post every round for every course, whether you played well or poorly.
- b. Do not post scores for FEGC events. The Handicap Chairman posts these for you. You are responsible for posting any other scores.
- c. Make sure you post from the correct tees.
- d. Adjust your score according to the USGA Equitable Stroke Control System below:

Your Current Handicap	Maximum Score on Any Hole
0-9	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9

**14. Fred Enke Pro Shop:** The Fred Enke Pro Shop has re-rated the golf course based on blue tees at 6726 yards, white tees at 6114 yards, and gold tees at 5602. The red tees remain the same as before for Dave Adler. New Score cards are available at the course. You may have noticed the new tees moved back.
