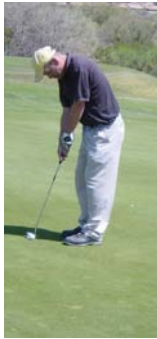




FRED ENKE GOLF CLUB NEWSLETTER June 2010

- 1. New Schedule:** Attached is the new golf schedule from June thru November 2010. Major events are:
 - a. Kane Cup: scheduled August 14 and 15
 - b. Club Championship: scheduled October 3, 9, and 10
 - c. Senior Kane Cup: scheduled first weekend in December
 - d. **Triple Club Discounts:** Tucson City Golf offers discounts to clubs playing more than 11 rounds from June 1 thru October 31, 2010. For **20** or more there is a **\$3** discount; for **32** or more a **\$6** discount, and for **44** or more a **\$9** discount. So you are encouraged to play as often as possible and bring a guest too. The more that play, the greater the discounts.

- 5. 2010 Membership Renewal:** Go to the AGA web site www.azgolf.org to pay your annual FEGC Dues of \$55 (this includes \$25 AGA Fee and \$30 Fred Enke fee) with a credit card. An additional \$5 can be added for the Hole-In-One fund. Certainly Cash or check are still acceptable and can be done by mail. To pay by credit or debit card, you must have an e-mail address. - 6. Scratch Play 2010 Tournament:** The second annual event of this tournament started in April with 27 players with 16 moving to the second round.
- 7. Best of the Year Tournament:** The new "Best of the Year" Tournament is underway. This is based on each golfer's best score per hole on a gross and net basis throughout the year. Cash prizes (to 25% of entrants) will be awarded at the end of the year. After eight rounds being completed by 37 members, Gross Score Leaders are Phil White, Pat O'Donnell, and Ed Vosberg with 60. Net Score Leaders are: Duane Fifer 47 and Bob Beal, Tom Owens, and Manny Trevino with 49.

8. Low Gross Tournament: An optional gross tournament is available each week that we play a net event. The entry fee is \$5. Ask the weekly coordinator.

9. Pace of Play: The pace of our play has generally been acceptable over the last few months with rounds at Fred Enke generally being 4 1/2 hours or less for the earlier groups. Unfortunately, we always seem to have 1 or 2 groups that fall behind and don't catch up and the final groups then wind up playing in about 5 hours. Rounds at Canoa Ranch were all pretty much at 5 hours, which is not good, but Canoa Hills was about 4 1/2 hrs. I know that many of you focus on keeping up with the group ahead of you, but **we need that commitment from everyone.** I'm asking all players to be aware of staying up with the group ahead and getting your playing partners to do the same. If you are in the 1st group, it's your responsibility to set a good pace, or at least keep up with the non-club group ahead.

10. Golf Tournament Coordinators: We are in need of more tournament coordinators. This is a fun job and you get to meet all the players and you get paid \$40. If you have some familiarity with MS Excel, the job is quite easy. See any Board Member for more information.

12. Trophy Case: many thanks to Tom Haack and Sal Mantione for designing and constructing our new trophy case in the Pro Shop. Please stop by to see the trophies and golf information on display.

13. Handicap Chair: It is expected that members will post ALL 18 hole scores regardless where they are played, not just Fred Enke Golf Club scores. If you do not have time or do not understand how to post, send the Handicap Chair the scores you have to be posted. Or he can show you how to sign on and use the computer located in the Fred Enke Pro Shop which is used solely for the purpose of posting members scores. Jeff Parfenchuck is the Handicap Chair with Steve Holly and Tom Owens forming the Handicap Committee. It is your responsibility to ensure your handicap is accurate.

- a. Post an accurate adjusted score for every round of golf that you play as soon as possible after the round. Post every round for every course, whether you played well or poorly.
- b. Do not post scores for FEGC events. The Handicap Chairman posts these for you. You are responsible for posting any other scores.
- c. Make sure you post from all the correct tees.
- d. Adjust your score according to the USGA Equitable Stroke Control System below:

Your Current Handicap	Maximum Score on Any Hole
0-9	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9
