1. **Membership:** Current membership is 161 members, including 5 new members. If you see someone you don't know, introduce yourself and welcome them to the golf club.
2. **2009 Membership Dues:** Membership dues for 2009 are \$55. Additionally there is a voluntary \$5 for the Hole-in-One fund. HIO currently has **\$1025**.
3. **New Schedule:** Attached is the new schedule for golf events June 1 – October 31, 2009. The Club Championship is scheduled September 27, October 3, and October 4.
4. **25th Anniversary Celebration:** March 21, 2009 there was a lot of "teeing up" at the Fred Enke Golf Course. With a scramble format, handicaps meant nothing and a good time was had by all. The purpose of the event was to celebrate the Fred Enke 25th Anniversary, and honor one of Southern Arizona's greatest sports families. Fred Enke Junior led a contingent of 20 family members spanning four generations. Joining the Enke family were former politicians, Tucson city staff, former course pros, golf course designers, and many of our men's and women's current and past club members. Blessed with mild and sunny weather, the event began with remarks and the rededication ceremony at 11:30 a.m. With box lunch in hand, tee off began at 1:00 p.m. The event concluded with hors d'oeuvres, laughter, smiles and joy. Craig Bauley (11), Larry Pagel (20), and Greg Cesarek (21) were in the Championship Flight. Bob Dalton (3rd gross), Patric Giclas (4th gross), Terry Kirchoffner (1st net), and Gary Maupin (3rd net) were in the 1st Flight. Darrell Nelson (1st gross), Steve Holly (2nd Net), and Ken Hyland (4th net) were in the 2nd Flight. Don Vosberg finished 4th net in the 3rd Flight. Congratulations to everyone.
8. **President's Cup:** The annual President's Cup Match Play Tournament completed. **Dave Adler** is the 2009 Champion defeating Bob Petrillo 5 and 4. Pat O'Donnell finished third and Gary Maupin fourth. Dave is also the first 2-time winner of this event. Congratulations.

12. City Courses Schedules:

- b. Silverbell and Dell Urich will remain cart path only thru October

13. Website Manager: Members with any corrections or additions of related material they would like to see posted on our website, please contact Steve Tilden.

14. Handicap Chair: It is expected that members will post ALL 18 hole scores regardless where they are played, not just Fred Enke Golf Club scores. If you do not have time or do not understand how to post, send the Handicap Coordinator the scores you have to be posted. Or he can show you how to sign on and use the computer located in the Fred Enke Pro Shop which is used solely for the purpose of posting members scores. Jeff Parfenchuck is the Handicap Chair. It is your responsibility to ensure your handicap is accurate.

- a. Post an accurate adjusted score for every round of golf that you play as soon as possible after the round. Post every round for every course, whether you played well or poorly.
- b. Do not post scores for FEGC events. The Handicap Chairman posts these for you. You are responsible for posting any other scores.
- c. Make sure you post from the correct tees.
- d. Adjust your score according to the USGA Equitable Stroke Control System below:

Your Current Handicap	Maximum Score on Any Hole
0-9	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9

15. Fred Enke Pro Shop: The Fred Enke Pro Shop has re-rated the golf course based on blue tees at 6726 yards, white tees at 6114 yards, and gold tees at 5602. The red tees remain the same as before for Dave Adler. New Score cards are available at the course. You may have noticed the new tees moved back.
