Important Message regarding Handicaps

The primary goal of our club is to hold fair and fun competitions each week. Having honest and accurate handicaps for everyone is the only way to make the competitions fair for all of our members.

We are asking each of you to be diligent in insuring that your own handicap is accurate. How do you do that? Follow the simple guidelines below:

1. Post an accurate adjusted score for every single round of golf that you play as soon as possible after the round. (Every round, every course, whether you played good or bad)
2. Make sure you post from the correct tees.
3. Adjust your score according to the USGA Equitable Stroke Control system below:

<u>Your current Handicap Index</u>	<u>Maximum score on any hole</u>
0- 9	Double Bogey
10-19	7
20-29	8
30-39	9
40+	10

4. Do not post for FEGC events. The Handicap Chairman will post those for you. You are responsible for posting all other scores.

Peer Review:

It is your responsibility, as a member of FEGC, to help insure that the club has accurate handicapping for all members. You can check the posting of other member's scores in the lower left corner of the page where you post your scores (Peer Review box). In addition, you can look up a member's scores on the AGA website at www.azgolf.org (click on Handicap link, enter name, & click on the name) from you home computer. If you are aware of any member that is not posting some scores or is not posting accurately, you should notify the Handicap Committee or any Board member.

Important Note:

The Board has appointed a Handicap Committee headed by Jody Campbell as Handicap Chairman. Members of the Committee are Steve Holly, Steve Kratochvil, Pat O'Donnell, and Lyle Tweet. One of the responsibilities of this committee will be to deal with issues of non-compliance and make appropriate handicap changes.
