## PRESIDENT'S REPORT &

AGA DELEGATE REPORT- Dave Adler Admin: Ty back as coordinator – Dave opened the meeting and after stating Ty would be a coordinator, then we discussed the results from last weekend at Del Lago, where the flight was changed for one player who played from the Gold Tees. After input from all in attendance (Pat O'Donnell arrived at end), we voted unanimously to not change a player's flight based on the tees played, as they are flighted based on their index/handicap from the regular tees.
